

Invitation for school children to participate the first Environmental island wide art competition of the Nature Conservation Society in Aluthgama.

Organizers: Nature Conservation Society, Sri Lanka

Theme: Environmental problems and destruction in Sri Lanka (for example waste, deforestation, drought, floods, landslides, etc.)

Art techniques: Drawing, painting and printmaking

Categories: 1 – Grade 6
2 – Grade 7
3 – Grade 8
4 – Grade 9
5 – Grade 10/11 (O-Level)
6 – Grade 12/13 (A-Level)

Eligibility conditions:

- Open for students from grade 6 to grade 13 (A-Level) in Sri Lanka (no area restriction)
- Paper size: maximum A2 (art paper)
- Each student can only send one piece of art

Labelling:

On the backside of the painting the following information have to be given (only fully filled information will be accepted):

1. Name and surname of the student
2. Age and grade
3. Address and phone number
4. Name of the school
5. Email (if available)
6. Short Description of the picture
7. Signature of parents, class teacher or principal

Deadline: the finished paintings with filled information should be **send until 20th of August 2016** (Postal stamp date) with registered post to the following address:

Prices: 1st price: 10.000 RS, 2nd price: 5.000 RS, 3rd price: 3.000 RS (for each category)
The price winner will be selected from a jury (3 person) for each category

The Winners will be informed by post and invited to the price awarding ceremony in Colombo in September/October 2016. The winning paintings will be shown in an exhibition during the ceremony.

With the participation in this competition each participant agrees that his painting can be used for the awareness program of the Nature Conservation Society.
