Information about the Dog Care Clinic

The Dog Care Clinic has been opened in July 2007 - by Marina Moebius, a German lady. Lot of support of friends and locals has been involved.

The clinic, in western standard, has surgery facilities and is equipped like a clinic in Europe.

Since, the hospital is well known in Sri Lanka – every day, puppies and sick dogs are dumped in front of the gate. Marina treats the dogs, which have an owner, free of charge.

Due to mass castrations and vaccinations the “picture” has changed already a lot in the south/west of the country.

The organisation Dog Care Clinic tries to re-home the dogs only in Sri Lanka. Disabled, sick and old dogs for whom not a home can be found are having a habitat in the clinic.

Working information

Working time:

5 days per week – from 8 a.m to 5 p.m (not fixed)
Weekend working welcome – castration projects

Duty:

Support of necessary work like:
Dog care, playing, feeding, cleaning, food preparing, support during surgery work and many more

Working clothes:

Long or three quarter trousers, t-shirts, shoes or boots, (old cloth)

Additional:

Veterinary trainees and students are welcome to support the work in the clinic

Food & Accommodation

Will be provided in a hotel, which is in walking distance or short transport to the Dog Care Center.

Requirements

Insurance policy (injury/damage), fluent in English, Veterinary knowledge is welcome, but not a precondition – rabis vaccination recommended

Minimum: 1 week (5 days)
