

Teaching projects English / German

Information about the Education Centre

The Education Development Centre (EDC) was build in 2006 from the Nature Conservation Society (NCS).

The educational project of the NCS includes free 6 month English- and Computer courses for children and youth (between 12 and 20 years) from families with low income.

The lectures are mainly afternoons, as most of the children are going to their normal schools in the morning.

Main task of the volunteers will be the practise of speaking (e.g. Spoken English) as the children are very shy to talk and have often also a low vocabulary. Therefore, the lectures are split in the normal part with the local teacher and the practical part with the volunteer (with support of the teacher).

Working information

Working time:

5 days / week – from 9 a.m to 11 a.m (German)
or 1 p.m to 5 p.m (English/others)

Duty:

Practice spoken English, support of English teacher, role plays, singing/dancing, ect.
(work will be together with the English teacher)

Working clothes:

Skirt and blouse, trousers and shirts, frock
→ Cloth should cover shoulders and knees / decent

Additional:

Teaching skills, independent preparations and contribution of own teaching material will be very helpful, but is no precondition
